Dear Parents,

This month our class will be exploring the lives and the customs of the Native American tribes found in Indiana. Our focus will be on this theme through out the month of November. Each student will be assigned to research a particular tribe that dwelt in our state over 300 years ago. Students will use their research to construct a typical Native American village that would have been found during that time period. Students will work in small groups to complete this project.

If you are able to donate any supplies to help our class with this construction, it would be greatly appreciated. Some needed items would be modeling clay (non-drying), craft sticks, artificial greenery and very small pumpkins, popcorn, and any type of dried beans. Green, blue, and brown washable paint are also needed.

In math, we will also be focusing on multiplying two and three digit numbers by a one digit number. This is difficult for many. So, please practice nightly.

Our study of the book of Genesis will conclude this month. We will move on to the story of Moses and the great exodus from Egypt. The focus our study has been on God's covenant with the people of Israel and his faithfulness to them. A strong emphasis was placed on the patriarchs and the lands in which they lived.
