Books for Babies

Supporting Women's Care Center of Northeast Indiana

What: Each student, in grades PK-6, is asked to EARN 1 book for a young child.

How: Each student is to call a relative, neighbor or adult friend and ask if there is a chore they can do for a small donation to the Books for Babies service project. 100% of the donation each student earns should go towards the purchase of an appropriate book for a child who is age birth to 5. Books can be new or very gently used. Very gently used books can be purchased at Goodwill or a garage sale. New books can be purchased at the Dollar Store or a Book Store. It only takes a little over a dollar earned to purchase 1 book. Possibly your child may pick out a favorite book, research the cost and then work towards earning that amount.

When: Students can bring the book into school anytime. Students will be asked to share their story of how they earned their book.

Why: Through earning the money to buy the book, students learn the value of money, the value of books, the value of hard work, the joy of purchasing for others, and the satisfaction of helping and serving the community. They also learn at a young age, that a person is never too young to help and no amount is too small to make a difference in another person's life.
